2024 ANNUAL REPORT OF THE AKWAMU DIVISIONAL COUNCIL (ASAFO PALACE)

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1.0 Introduction

This document presents the report on the activities of the Akwamu Divisional Council for the year 2024. It marks the 4th report in a series that captures the programs and activities undertaken during the year, highlighting the progress made. The report is organized around the key activities and events that occurred, including land allocations in the Asafo communities, official assignments on behalf of Otumfoɔ, the Ashanti Regional House of Chiefs, and the Kumasi Traditional Council. It also includes details about the Awukudae festivals organized by the Asafohene/Akwamuhene and the cases and complaints (including Ntam cases) addressed by the Akwamu Divisional Council and the Asafo Fetrɔ courts.

2.0 MEMBERS OF THE AKWAMU DIVISIONAL COUNCIL

The Akwamu Divisional Council, which operates as a subsidiary of the Kumasi Traditional Council, consists of the Akwamu Fekuo and Asafo Fetrɔ. The council is led by Asafohene/Akwamuhene Akyamfo Asafo Boakye Agyemang-Bonsu, who is supported by a dedicated secretarial staff. The Akwamu Fekuo, aside from the Amanhenes, includes the Asafo Fetrɔ, Adum Fetrɔ, and Twafoɔ Fetrɔ. Formed by the Asanteman Traditional Council, the Akwamu Divisional Council functions under the Kumasi Traditional Council's oversight. This council, together with the Asafohene and Elders (Asafo Fetrɔ) courts, addresses a range of issues religious, cultural, social, economic, and developmental that are relevant to the Akwamu Divisional Council and the Asafo community.

3.0 CASES HANDLED

Although the Akwamu Divisional Council manages various cases, the majority of those handled by Akwamu Fekuo are primarily Otumfo Ntamkeseɛ cases or cases assigned to them by Otumfoɔ for resolution. Some of these cases, marked as resolved, are the Ntamkeseɛ cases that have been forwarded to Otumfoɔ. (i.e. the Kumasi Traditional Council) as per the traditional demands.

4.0 AWUKUDAE FESTIVALS CELEBRATION

The Awukudae Festival is a traditional Ashanti festival celebrated by the Ashanti people in Ghana. It is part of the Aday Festival cycle, which includes two main observances: Awukudae and Akwasidae. Awukudae is celebrated every 40 days and occurs on a Wednesday.

The festival is an important ancestral rite performed by the chiefs and elders of the Akan clan around Kumasi. It involves various traditional ceremonies, including drumming, dancing, and offerings to the ancestors. The festival is marked by the drumming of Atumpan and single-air drums, but not Fontomfrom drums. The ceremonies are carried out in the Stool-House, where the drumming symbolizes seeking protection for the guardian ancestral deities and unifying the people under the reign of the ruling king.

During the festival, it is believed that the ancestors, known as Nsamanfoo, are wandering around to see if the festival is being observed properly. It is also a time for charitable acts, such as feeding the hungry and helping the sick. The festival is deeply rooted in the cultural and spiritual traditions of the Ashanti people and serves as a way to honor and remember their ancestors

Awukudae celebrations were celebrated by Akyamfoo, together with his council of elders and the general public at the Asafo Palace on 31st January, 13th March, 24th April, 5th June, 17th July, 28th August, 9th October, and 20th November. Below are pictures of the respective celebrations.

5.0 SWEARING- IN CEREMONY

Among the series of activities that were held at the palace, there was also a swearing- in ceremony for Nana Kwame Oduro as Apampatia Dikro on the 3rd December, 2024 and on the 17th of December, 2024, Nana Afia Sarpong was also enstooled as Sompa Obaapanin for her good services to the Akwamu Divisional Council.

6.0 DESTOOLMENT

On November 5, 2024, Apesemaka Obaapanin Nana Afia Asantewaa was removed from her position (destooled) due to actions deemed inconsistent with Asante traditions. At a later date, Nana Prempeh, Tabere Dikro, was also removed for aligning with Yabihene as Gyaasehene, an action considered contrary to Asante laws and constitution. The necessary traditional rites were performed to formalize Prempeh's destoolment. At the Kumasi Traditional Council meeting on March 13, 2025, Otumfuo Osei Tutu II, Asantehene, further annulled Nana Prempeh's enstoolment by Yabihene, reinforcing adherence to established Asante traditions.

7.0 BACK TO SCHOOL PROJECT

7.1 Supports to Junior High School

The back-to-school project is an educational initiative by Otumfo's Akwamuhene/Asafohene Asafo Boakye Agyemang-Bonsu. The Educational project was commenced on the 2022 academic year and continued on 2023 and 2024 academic year. Educational items such as mathematical sets were distributed among students who were about writing Basic Educational Certificate Examination (BECE) under the Asafohene's townships in Kumasi Metropolis, Atwima Kwanwoma District and Amansie West District. 8.0 SYMPOSIUM/ BOOK LAUNCH ON 150TH ANNIVERSARY OF SARGRENTI WAR.

The symposium and book launch marking the 150th anniversary of the Sargrenti War was a significant event held at the Great Hall of Kwame Nkrumah University of Science and Technology (KNUST) on 17th May, 2024. This event was part of the silver jubilee celebrations of Otumfuo Osei Tutu II, the 16th occupant of the Golden Stool.

The Sargrenti War, fought in 1874 between the British colonial forces under Sir Garnet Wolseley and the Asante Kingdom, saw the burning of the Asantehene's palace and the looting of many priceless artifacts. The symposium featured notable speakers, including Professor Thomas C. McCaskie from Birmingham University, who provided a detailed historical account of the war.

The highlight of the event was the launch of a 700-page book titled "History of Asante,"

authored by Otumfuo Sir Agyeman Prempeh II and edited by Dr. McCaskie. The book delves into the incidents of the Sargrenti War and provides a comprehensive historical account of the Asante Kingdom.

The event was attended by Ministers of State, Members of Parliament, traditional leaders, religious leaders, members of academia, and historians. Asafohene was present to embrace the ceremony. It was a momentous occasion that celebrated the rich history and cultural heritage of the Asante people.

9.0 KUNTUNKUNI DURBAR

The Kuntunkuni Durbar is a significant event held at the Manhyia Palace to commemorate the 150th anniversary of the Sagrenti War between the Asantes and British colonial leaders. Named after the traditional mourning cloths of the Asantes, Kuntunkuni, the durbar serves as a solemn occasion to mourn the over 4,000 Asante soldiers who perished in the war and reflect on the impact the war had on Kumasi.

The event takes place at the Dwabrem grounds in the Manhyia Palace and features the arrival of traditional rulers, paramount chiefs, and queen mothers, often in palanquins under black or red parasols. The Asantehene, Otumfuo Osei Tutu II, presides over the durbar, which includes traditional musical performances, spiritual displays by fetish priests and priestesses, and the display of looted Asante artifacts.

The Kuntunkuni Durbar is not only a time for mourning but also a celebration of Asante culture and heritage, bringing together high-profile government officials, diplomats, and other dignitaries. It is a powerful reminder of the resilience and rich history of the Asante people.

10.0 25TH ANNIVERSARY OF THE INSTALLATION OF NANA AKYENA KWAGYAN NUAMA V (ESSUOWINHENE)

The 25th anniversary of the installation of Nana Akyena Kwagyan Nuama V, the Essuowinhene, was celebrated with great enthusiasm and reverence. The event included a three-day health screening exercise, benefiting residents of 14 communities in the Amansie West District. The health screening was part of the Chief's silver jubilee celebration and was conducted by a combined medical team from the Ghana West Africa Medical Mission, Dada Foundation, and Wisconsin International University College.

The celebration also saw the inauguration of a 20-bed expansion block at the Essuowin Health Centre, financed by Nana Akyena Kwagyan Nuama V. This new facility includes an OPD, separate male and female wards, a maternity block, and self-contained flats for health personnel. The Chief emphasized the importance of providing quality healthcare to his people and called on residents to contribute to the development of Essuowin.

11.0 OTUMFOO'S ANNIVERSARY CLEAN-UP EXERCISE

The Otumfoo's Anniversary Clean-Up Exercise was a significant event held in Kumasi to mark the 25th anniversary of Otumfoo Osei Tutu II's reign. The Asantehene, Otumfoo Osei Tutu II, led the clean-up exercise, which saw the participation of various dignitaries, including the Kumasi Metropolitan Assembly Chief Executive Samuel Pyne, Ashanti Regional Minister Simon Osei Mensah, and members of the Asante Professionals Club.

The exercise took place on March 30, 2024, and involved cleaning key areas in Kumasi, such as

the Kumasi Airport roundabout, Suame Roundabout, Kejetia, and Adum. Business activities were suspended from 6 a.m. to 12 noon to allow full public participation. The event aimed to promote cleanliness and environmental awareness in the city.

Otumfoɔ Osei Tutu II and his entourage toured the principal streets of Kumasi to inspect the work done during the exercise. The Ashanti Regional Minister commended the residents for their active participation and encouraged them to maintain cleanliness in their surroundings.

It was a remarkable event that showcased the community's commitment to environmental sustainability and honored the legacy of Otumfoɔ Osei Tutu II's leadership.

16.0 OTUMFOɔ'S 25TH ANNIVERSARY ADAE KESE CELEBRATION (AKWASIDAE).

The 25th Anniversary of Otumfoɔ Osei Tutu II's enstoolment as the Asantehene was marked with a grand Akwasidae-kese durbar at the Manhyia Palace in Kumasi on 12th May, 2024. This celebration, also known as Adae Kese, is a significant event in the Asante calendar, held every six weeks to honor the ancestors and celebrate the Golden Stool.

The meeting, on the approval of Akyamfoɔ was called to order at 11:57 AM by Kyeame Abebrese.

(CASE ONE)

ABIRAHENE VS NANA OSEI BONSU ABUSUAFO

Abirahene and Nana Osei Bonsu late Abirahene Abusuafo had a case at the court and Nananom Akwamufɔɔ told them to withdraw the case from the court. As they went there to request the court to terminate the legal proceedings, the Asinfoɔ told the court that, they do not want Nananom Akwamufɔɔ and Otumfɔɔ to resolve the case.

We inform Nananom Akwamufɔɔ about what happened. We invited the entire Asinfoɔ Abusua to meet us at Manhyia and told them to come to the Asafo Palace so that we can discuss everything and inform Otumfɔɔ.

The Asinfoɔ Abusua has been called several times to appear before the Akwamu council but they refused to come. The court also ordered that Nananom Akwamu should feedback the court after resolution and if they are not able to settle the case then the court will proceed with resolving the case.

The court ordered that Nananom Fekufo should settle the case and bring report of their judgment to court.

SUGGESTIONS BY NANANOM

Kyerapatrehene- If without Nana Osei Bonsu we can settle the case then I suggested we should settle it and send the court the final feedback on how the case went.

Soodohene- We should inform Asantehene about what has happen because we serve Asantehene and also inform Asantehene that the family of Nanasei Bonsa said they don't want Asantehene to settle to settle case but rather wants the court.

Tetremhene- I support what Soodohene said we should inform Asantehene about it since he gave us the case to come and settle. We should inform in that the family doesn't want Nananom Akyamfo top settle the case but rather the court.

Nkwanta Esaasehene- Late Nana Osei Bonsu Abusuafo are acting very disrespectful to Asantehene, to say that Asantehene who is the owner of the land you have taken to court and they claim they will not even allow him to settle but rather the court the I suggest that since he gave us the case to come and settle, we should go and inform Asantehene about the discussion of late Nana Osei Bonsu Abusua.

Tanosohene- Before we will go inform Asantehene about the family's decision we should charge them for contempt over their actions and allow Nana Abirahene to present the contempt charges so that we can go and inform Asantehene about it.

Akrafohene- I also agree with what Nananom have suggested that they should be charged for contempt after the contempt charges are being presented then we go ahead and inform Asantehene about the situation, also Abirahene should present his charge of contempt.

Suaduhene- They should be charged for their disrespectful actions towards Asantehene and Nananom Akwamufo so that we can go and inform Asantehene about the case he gave to us to come and settle between Abirahene and of the late Nana Osei Bonsu Abusua.

Adumhene- Before we will go and inform Asantehene about the late Nana Osei Bonsu Abusuafo action we should also go back to court to inform the court that the instructions that was giving to them Nana Osei Bonsu Abusua has refused to go by it before we can go ahead and inform Asantehene about the case so that if we are asked by Asantehene what step did we take can let him about that one as well.

Kyeame Dwomo- We should allow Abirahene to present his charge of contempt and inform Asantehene about it.

Kyeame Oti- I also agree with Nananom that the family should be charged for contempt and after Abirahene presents the contempt charges we can go and inform Asantehene about the case that Nana Osei Bonsu Abusuafo has refused that the case should be settle by Nananom Akwamufo and will not even allow him Asantehene to also settle the case but rather will allow the court insisted to settle the case.

AKYAMFOO SPEAKS

He asked Abirahene to do the necessary rites to present to Otumfo and inform him about what has happen for prefect resolution.

(CASE TWO)

FUMAN NO.2 DISPUTE

Kofi Nyame who is the Abusuapanin of Fuman No. 2 speaks on behalf of Fuman No.2. He explains that Akyamfo asked Didahene and Kyeame Dwomo to go and make investigations about the history of Fuman No.2.

Kofi Nyame also said that they have also done their research about where they swore to Asantehene or Techimanhene and have presented it to the registrar of Asafo/Akwamu.

OTUMFOO MPOMPONSUO SPEAKS

The elders of Fuman No. 2 should exercise patient and give us some time to inform Asantehene about it before we can take any further actions.

AKYAMFOO SPEAKS

If Otumfo Mponponsuo has asked the case to be reserved, accepted. I have asked him to make the acquire inquiries and take responds later.

(CASE THREE)

ADUMHENE VS AKOBEAHENE

Baffour Adumhene speaks that Baffour Ankobea is still selling the lands which they had issues about and was to be settled by Akyamfo who was destooled.

Baffour Adum also said he has an issue with Otumfo Twafoghene.

SUGGESTION BY NANANOM

Kyeapatrehene- We should invite Nana Ankobea to come and explain his side of the issue and see whether we will settle it here or sent to Otumfo.

Otumfo Soodo- Both judges are not present to settle the case so we should inform Otumfo about it if he will settle the case himself or give it back to us to settle.

Tetremhene- The case has been there for long so let's inform Otumfo and settle it. Ankobea should also be invited to see if he will agree or disagree to invoke an oath.

Nkwanta Esaase- Lets invite Ankobea in front of Baffour Adumhene and ask him if he will agree or disagree to invoke an oath.

Tanosohene-

Didahene-

Ahemoa Gyataba-

Akrafo-

Suaduhene- He pleaded that Ankobea and Baffour should perform the necessary rites so that they can present them to Otumfo.

OTUMFOO MPOMPONSUO SPEAKS

He articulated that Otumfoo sent him to inform Nananom Fekufoo to leave the case for him. Nananom Fekufoo is the one to follow up with the case so that they can settle it.

He also said that with the case of Ankobea and Akwaboah, they have to perform the necessary rites so that Nananom Fekuo will present them to Otumfoo.

Case was adjourned to next court sitting.

The meeting, on the approval of Akyamfoo was called to order at 11:50 AM by Kyeame Abebrese.

ABIRAHENE, ASANTE AND KWAKU NSIAH

KYEAME ABEBRESE SPEAKS

Not long ago a case between Abirahene, Asante and Kwaku Nsiah was given to Kontire and Akwamu to settle. When the case was given to Kontire and Akwamu to settle Kwaku Nsiah's family took it to court, but the committees work was to demarcate boundaries between Abirahene and Asante but didn't get the chance to inspect Kwaku Nsiah's family boundaries because the case was still pending in court but now that they have withdrawal the case from court Kwaku Nsiah's family are not willing to go with us to inspect their boundary because they have not heard it from Akyamfoo so today they are here in front of Akyamfoo and Nananom Akwamufoo to inform them himself because of transparency.

AKYAMFOO SPEAKS

This isn't a case that was supposed to be brought before Nananom again, but all same Kwaku Nsiah's family should go with them to inspect their boundary. Kwaku Nsiah Ketewaa was the one who came to stand in on behalf of Kwaku Nsiah himself.

(CASE ONE)

BABA SIAKA VS NANA DANKANSUA

Kyeame Oti speaks on behalf of Baba Siaka's family saying three weeks today Baba Siaka came to report Nana Dankansua to the court (Nananom Akwamufo) that the land that they were asked not to work on Nana Dankansua is still working on the land. Nananom appointed Kyeame Oti to go and inspect it is true that Nana Dankansua is indeed working on the land, when I got there workers were on the land working so I approached and asked them who instructed them to work on the land they said Nana Dankansua. So we meet with Nana Dankansua and asked him about the people working on the land and he accepted that he is the one who ordered them to work on the land. So that is what happened there when Nananom Akwamufo sent us.

SUGGESTION BY NANANOM

Nananom all agreed that if this is the case at hand and if Nana Dankansua himself has accepted his mistakes, then he has bleach Otumfo's Ntam and should be cited for contempt.

Didahene was the only person who disagreed that if Nana Dankansua can be cited for contempt, then the inspection was supposed to be done by some of Nana Akwamufo and maybe on Kyeame so that they will be witnessed in the case when the case is called anywhere so to him Nana Dankansua cannot be fully be cited for contempt.

AKYAMFOO SPEAKS

Dankansua is being disrespectful to the court, he has been sermon so many times but he refuses to come, he has been charged with contempt, he will be called again, if he fails to appear before the court we will take the necessary actions against him.

(CASE TWO)

BAFFOUR ADUMHENE VS. SARFO AFRANCHO

Months ago I was on my way to Asantehemaa's palace and Sarfo who is from Afrancho meet me and invoke Otumfoɔ's Ntam on me that the land that was given to snnit people to work on he was given some of the land and because of that he has invoke Otumfoɔ Ntamkeseɛ on me, I didn't invoke some because he doesn't have any right to invoke Otumfoɔ Ntamkeseɛ on me.

SARFO AFRANCHO SPEAKS

He claims Baffour Adumhene is his king.

He also claims he was sent by the who community of Afrancho to come and invoke Otumfoɔ Ntam on him.

SUGGESTIONS BY NANANOM

Nananom all agreed that Sarfo Afrancho who claims that the whole community of Afrancho sent him to come and invoke Otumfoɔ Ntamkeseɛ on him have invoke Ntamhunu because

- He has no right to invoke Otumfoɔ Ntam on his own chief.
- He holds no position to invoke Otumfoɔ Ntamkeseɛ on Adumhene.
- Again, Otumfoɔ Ntamkeseɛ should not be given to some to deliverer on anyone's behalf.

Base on this he should be cited for contempt of invoking Ntamhunu.

AKYAMFOɔ SPEAKS

The great oath is pronounced when these is the need for something good to be given or brought to you but not when you think it's in your right to prounced it, the work was given out to surveyor by Otumfoɔ and Adumhene is ignorant about the happenings there. Therefore, you have invoked Ntamhunu and you will be cited for contempt.

(CASE THREE)

**NANA NKWANTABISA VS BECEHME MPANINFOO AND BECHEMHEMAA
(NTAMKESE)**

Kojo Adjei told in on behalf of Nkwantabisa, he is the brother of Nkwantabiasa. He claims that he has been coming with him here to the place ever since the case began. He is here to plead on Nkwantabiasa behalf for permission that he is not feeling well and that he has travelled to Accra for treatment. NANA OKOFO NKWANTABISA (BECHEM KrontieHene) VS BECHEM MPANINFO AND BECHEMANHEMAA

Case has been withdrawn from Akwamu court to Otumfo.

Kwabena Donkor from Bechem speaks- He invoked an oath of Otumfoɔ on Nana Frimpong and Nana Okofo Nkwantabiasa.

(CASE FOUR)

KOFI ARHIN VS ABUSUAPANIN AMANTU KWADWO, KWASI NKRUMAH, BRUCE ASUMANG, KWAKU FREDUA AND KWAKU NSIAH (ADANKWAME)

The meeting, on the approval of Akyamfoɔ was called to order at 11:50 AM by Kyeame Abebrese.

(CASE ONE)

OPANIN OWUSU DARKWAH VS NANA AKWABOAH BRENYA (KENIAGO ADONTEHENE AND OPANIN OSEI YEBOAH, OPANIN AKWASI BOATENG

Nana Akrafo pleaded on behalf of the Opanin Owusu Darkwah, the family of Keniago Abusuapanin came to inform me this morning that he is not feeling well so I should come and help them seek permission for him for the case to be adjourned to next two weeks.

Abusuapanin Yaw Boateng stood before Nananom and invoked an oath of Otumfo on the entire Keniago family claiming to be the Abusuapanin that he Abusuapanin Yaw Boateng is the next to be on the throne.

INTOREGATION BY NANANOM TO ABUSUAPANIN YAW BOATENG

Tanosohene-Where were you when the Chief of Keniago died and what did you do?

Abusuapanin Yaw Boateng- I was out of town when he died. But I came back after some months and when I returned I heard that they have opened the throne for family members to contest by Abusuapanin.

Tanosohene- Prior to Abusuapanin Yaw Boateng's explanation on why he has invoked Otumfoɔ Ntamkeseɛ on Keniago Abusuapanin and the rest of the family members he has invoke Ntamhunu.

Ahemoa Gyata- When you came and heard that they have opened the throne for family members to contest what did you do about?

Abusuapanin Yaw Boateng- The time I heard about the news the names had already been submitted to the Abusuapanin so I also decided not to go and meet him myself but rather I will go and discuss with any chief that I know to lead me to the Abusuapanin and tell my request

Kyeame Oti-When Keniago Chief was alive were you around and when he passed on to were you around?

Abusuapanin Yaw Boateng- Yes was around when Keniago Chief was alive and when he passed on to I was around.

Kyeame Oti-When he was alive was did you do towards the throne.

Abusuapanin Yaw Boateng- Late Keniago Chief was not even the rightful herein to the throne.

Kyeame Oti- what clan are you from?

Abusuapanin Yaw Boateng- Asona Clan

Kyeame Oti- And where were you when the Keniago chieftaincy dispute was being settling at Manhyia, All the people you are seeing here were always present at Manhyia so where were you at that time?

Abusuapanin Yaw Boateng- As I stated earlier, I was not in town.

Kyeame Oti- When you returned and heard that Keniago throne has been ruled in favor of a particular family what step did you take?

Abusuapanin Yaw Boateng-I didn't take any step towards the ruling.

Kyeame Abebrese- Who was late Keniago Chief to you?

Abusuapanin Yaw Boateng-He was my brother

Kyeame Abebrese- And when he passed on what was your contribution to his funeral.

Abusuapanin Yaw Boateng-I contributed nothing to his funeral

Kyeame Abebrese-Do you know the people who did his funeral?

Abusuapanin Yaw Boateng- No.

Nkwanta-Esaase- When you came to town and heard that it has been announced that if you are interested to be the next Keniago Chief what step did you take. Again, who was late Keniago Chief to you?

Abusuapanin Yaw Boateng- I didn't take any step. He was like my brother but not brother from the same mother.

**SUGGESTIONS BY NANANOM FEKUOFO IN REGARDS TO ABUSUAPANIN YAW
BOATENG'S INVOKING OTUMFO NTAM**

Tetremhene- You didn't take any action when the case was being settling at Manhyia by Otumfo but waited still the ruling to be done and you have now appeared before us today to say a different thing, we can't accept it prior to that Abusuapanin Yaw Boateng Keniago has invoked Ntamhunu.

Tanoso-I agree with Tetremhene Yaw Boateng has invoked Ntamhunu. With all that he have said now I don't need to think about it whether he has invoked Ntamhunu or not it is clear that he has invoked Ntamhunu.

Didahene-A case that Otumfo has settle cannot be change, if you are here to tell us to help you go and plead to Otumfo would have been okay but to come and stand before Nananom today claiming that a case that have been settled by Otumfo should be settle again. Abusuapanin has invoked Ntamhunu.

Gyataba- I agreed with Didahene, a case that Otumfo has settled and giving his final ruling can't not be changed by his own Ntam but rather if you came here to inform us to lead you to him and send your petition to him it will have been better so prior to that Abusuapanin Yaw Boateng has invoked Ntamhunu.

Abramhene- I don't think Abusuapanin Yaw Boateng he is a residence of Keniago tow because if he is he would have known the people who did late Keniago chief's funeral because when he was asked who are the people that did late Keniago chief funeral he is not able to even mention one person name so meaning he knows nothing about this Keniago stool and prior to that he has invoke Ntamhunu.

Akrafohene- I don't even know who is behind him and advising him that has landed him into these mess if truly you are part of the family you would have known all the preparation that was made towards late Keniago chief's funeral and also you will be involved in it as well not now that everything has been done without you and now you want to benefit from the opportunity that has come afterwards, you don't even know the name of the Abusuapanin who is now taking care of everything and you think you can come and invoke Otumfo Ntam to claim the stool, Abusuapanin Yaw Boateng has invoke Ntamhunu prior to his own narration for the case.

Kyeame Nti- Going forward whenever you want to take any actions concerning anything you have to think over it well and be also extremely careful so that it doesn't land you anywhere you are not supposed to be. Somewhere 2008 when this Keniago issue started pending it's been like 16years now all this family members you are seeing here today were all involve they all had the opportunity to also say was they know about the stool and how they are all related to the Keniago stool and why they can ascend the throne all that time you were nowhere to be found who were

you expecting to watch your back for you and later come and enjoy now that everything is okay, when you came you were expected to bring to Dwaatoa so that we can see how best we can help you but not to come and invoke Ntam and claim a throne you don't know anything about it, prior to that Abusuapanin Yaw Boateng has invoke Ntamhunu.

Kyeame Abebrese- If you know what NtamkeseE can do to one's life you won't have invoked it into this your case, It's been like 4years when the opportunity came for everybody who can ascend the Keniago throne to bring their names where were you all this while and you think from nowhere a case that has been ruled by Otumfo you can come and use just a second to invoke his own Ntam to counter it, whoever advised you didn't do you any good, Abusuapanin Yaw Boateng has invoke a big Ntamhunu.

Nananom all agreed that Abusuapanin Yaw Boateng has invoked Ntamhunu and shout be cited for contempt.

ACTING PRESIDENT SUADUHENE SPEAKS

I agreed with all that Nananom have said, when this case was pending the ups and downs were all done by Abusuapanin Osei Yeboah we didn't see you being involved and now he has been accepted by Otumfo that he is Keniago Abusuapanin now, when the opportunity came we had couple of people who sent their plead to your Abusuapanin in fact this case has been called more than 3 times at Akwamufei you didn't even appear before us here in any of the days that the case was called and you think you can come from nowhere today and invoke Otumfo NtamkeseE concerning a case that has been ruled by Otumfo, you are just messing with Otumfo Ntam Yaw Boateng has invoked Ntamhunu and should be cited for contempt for invoking Ntamhunu. Again, Otumfo has accepted Osei Yeboah as Keniago Abusuapanin so we should all take note.

NANANOM ADVICE KWAME PIPIM AFTER HE PERFORMED HIS RITES OF CONTEMPT

Tetremhene-I don't know why you people play with NtamkeseE. You have appeared before Otumfo and your name has been cancelled why then will you appear before us today with a different name and deny of being the same person Otumfo cancelled your name from the list that was presented to him, advise yourself and not to repeat this again is any unlawful act and shouldn't repeat itself again.

Tanosohene- don't joke with the words of Otumfo, your name was not cancelled by us Akwamufo but rather Otumfo himself, your name that has been called cannot be erase it has been kept at archive as evidence so you can never ever deny that, and one thing you should that note is that any case that has been ruled by Otumfo nobody on this earth can challenge him

unless he decides to changed it so with you have really worried your entire family with your own mistake. This should be your last time of trying to deny that and it shouldn't happen again that is your name and nothing can change that name not to be your name, I will plead on his behalf to be forgiven.

Ahemoa Gyata- If your family were to responsible family an apology has been render to Otumfoɔ long time but yet you still have the guts to come and lie in front of us today and how do you want us to lead you and go and plead on your behalf to Otumfoɔ you really worry your family and your next generation this shouldn't happen again.

Abirahene- This shouldn't repeat itself again, even if you wanted to counter this you were supposed to pushed your family and be behind their back but rather you chose to come and face us yourself because of what, this should be the last time you will repeat this act again. I am also pleading that we should forgive him.

Akrafohene- I agree with all that nananom have said he has really worried his family and his next generation but I am also pleading on his behalf to be forgiven as well.

Kyeame Nti- I agree with what Abramhene said if you are wise person, you won't have even face us yourself but rather you should have been behind them again, I will also plead that we should forgive him

Kyeame Abebrese- As Akyeame Nti said in his previous statement by now any apology has been sent to Otumfoɔ long time because note that this that you have done will forever be an history for the young generation to come and witness and mind you your name will forever be mentioned anytime this history will be said in your family and they will be disappointed in you that because of your selfishness they can no longer ascend the Keniango throne again so you need to be humble by now and again I will also plead on his behalf to also be forgiven.

Nananom advised Kwame pipim not to repeat what he did again because what he did for Otumfoɔ to revoke his family from being on the throne is still in archives. Kwame Pipim should render an apology to Manhyia and his family.

SUADU ACTING PRESIDENT SPEAKS

Kwame Pipim, you have really worried your family and the next generation from your family and the next generation from your family. Go and render a huge apology to your family.

You have to be very humble and respectful before Nananom Fekuo because for your case to reach before Otumfo, we Nananom Fekuo will be the one to send it or inform Otumfoɔ.

(CASE TWO)

AMA ACHIAA VS DUMAKWAE

Kyeame Nti made it known to the court that Ama Achiaa informed his Dwaatoa ni that she is not feeling well and that he wants him to plead to the court on his behalf for the case to be adjourned to next two weeks.

(CASE THREE)

BABA SIAKA VS NANA DANKANSUA

Kyeame Nti informed Baba Siaka that their case has been adjourned to next two weeks and its order from above so when we meet next two weeks, we will brief you all about the message from above.

(CASE FOUR)

MICHEAL AKWASI OWUSU VS AMA ACHIAA

Both parties didn't appear in court but rather sent people to come and plead on their behalf for their case to be adjourned to next two weeks. Permission was granted case adjourned to next two weeks.

(CASE FIVE)

KOFI ARHIN VS ABUSUAPANIN KWADWO, KWASI NKRUMAH, BRUCE ASUMANG, KWAKU FREDUA AND KWAKU NSIAH (ADANKWAME)

Kwaku Addai came to stand in on behalf of Abusuapanin Amadu Kwaku Kwadwo that he is not feeling well so he should come and inform Nananom about it for the case should be adjourned.

SUGGESTION BY NANANOM

Some of them decided that since Abusuapanin is refusing to show up before the court and using sickness as an excuse we should give him up to next two weeks to show up before the before the court. Some also said that since Abusuapanin is not the only person who was summoned by Kofi Arhin the rest of the people that are have been summoned should also appear before the court next two weeks even Abusuapanin does not appear we will hear start the proceedings.

Kofi Arhin to was told that if he wants his sister to stand in and continue the case for him in his absent as he said its allowed but he will have to bring power of attorney that will serve as an advice that he is the one handing over to her sister in front of nananom.

SUADUHENE ACTING PRESIDENT SPEAKS

This case is clear to me. After sitting Akyeamefo should see to it that whenever Abusuapanin is they should look for him and inform him to be present at court next two weeks and if they don't show up by the power vested in, they by Otumfoɔ they will listening to the case and see best they can solve it without Abusuapanin. Again, Kofi Arhin should exercise patient and wait still next two weeks to see the next step.

Case was adjourned to next two weeks.

SUGGESTION BY NANANOM

Tetremhene-He suggested that Nananom should send someone to go and check of Abusuapanin Amadu is truly not feeling well.

Tanosohene-Abusuapanin should be given the last chance to appear before nananom and if he refused to come them, we judge him as being guilty.

Didahene- Kofi Arhin should give power of attorney to his sister so that when his time is up for him to go, he can go and his sister will stand in for him.

Nana Akrafo- I agreed with Didahene.

Kyeame Osei Broni-Anytime we call this case, none of the defendants appear before us.

Kyeame Abebrese-He explained further of what the case is about. That, Abusuapanin Amadu and others took money from Kofi Arhin that they will enstool him as the king but they refused.

Since some Nananom of have fear idea about the case already I will want them to continue with it for us. They should go to Bechem and ask about it and bring as feedback next two weeks.

Abusuapanin was asked to reciprocate the said Ntam invoked upon him but he plea he was going to inform Obaapanin before reciprocating that Ntam invoked upon him. He later plea Nananom to allow him to go and resolve the family issue before returning to inform Nananom Akwamufo.

Terchirehene speaks on behalf of the Abusuapanin for Dwomohene. He said, Abusuapanin of Dwomohene has already presented his terms of contempt charged and he is here to apologize of his bad behavior he portrayed.

SUGGESTION BY NANANOM

Nananom suggested that, he should be forgiven if he has realized his mistake and have apologized.

AKYAMFOO SPEAKS

Your apology has been accepted. Dwomo Abusuapanin and the queen mother should organize and arrange the funeral of Dwomohene and bury him. They should bring feedback after everything.

(CASE THREE)

KENSERE AFFAIRS

He said he heard that the family of Kensere said that, they presented their charge of contempt of him. The family of Kensere came to him and he questioned them about it so Ponponso said he called Dabanka and asked him if the family of Kensere has presented any charge of contempt to him and Dabanka said yes, they did.

Mponponsuo informed the entire Council of Akwamu that the family of Kensere should never say it anywhere that they presented their charge of contempt to him. Mponpomsuo further explained that he is the Kyeame between Akwamu and Manhyia.

OPANIN AKWASI AGYEMANG VS OHWIM ABUSUAPANIN

SUADUHENE SPEAKS

He stood before Akyamfo to brief him of his ruling on the case. But he ended saying he invited Ohwimhene but he did not honour it even though the family did as Akyamfo had ordered him Suaduhene to handle the case.

AKYAMFOO'S STATEMENT

Tanosohene- Asked for details pertaining the issued at hand.

Kyeame Abebrese- He explained vividly how it all happened.

SUGGESTIONS BY NANANOM

Tetremhene- He intimated that Ohwimhene had refused to want was required of him, and then he doesn't know how to help him.

Nkwanta-Esaase- He suggested not Ohwimhene should be summoned again and if he doesn't then we have him to his was.

Tanoso- He suggested against the suggestion of Nkwanta-Esaase. Since it seems to him that we would be preparing him.

Didahene and the rest of the council all suggested that they want wait for him to do the necessary rites leaving him to his hoes as since his majesty's presence in the state is not yet known.

AKYAMFO STATEMENT

Akyamfo intimated that they still seek after him and render our help to him and avoid the possible woes which can begin him because he is still their brother. And in one way or the other the entire council will be affected since he is a member.

Furthermore, he intimated saying he will be sending Kyeame Oti to go after him to go and bring him so they will inquire and prepare themselves to appear before the court of Otumfo.

AKYAMFO SPEAKS

Ohwimhene came to me early morning after I sent Suaduhene. He informed me that he met Mponponsuo and he asked him to present Abusuapanin change of contempt and he agreed to do it.

KYEAME ABEBRESE EXPLAIN FURTHER ABOUT OHWIMHENE AND HIS ABUSUAPANIN CASE

Ohwimhene destooled his Abusuapanin for disrespecting his decision by going ahead to destooled Odikro because Abusuapanin has no right to destooled any Odikro.

AKYAMFO SPEAKS

We should try and find him and help him to present his change of contempt so that we will be able to present it before Otumfoɔ when we are called.

MANSO FAWOTRIKYE (NTAM KESEƐ)

Abusuapanin of Manso Nkwanta (Fawotirikye) speaks- He intimated that he successor of the throne and who had falling sick and had appointed another successor to succeed him. The family took the appointed one to Manso Nkwantamanhene for approval.

During the Enstoolment of the new appointee, Eric Okyere appeared and ceased the Enstoolment with his claims that he too sits to ascend the throne. This back and forth resulted in invoking Otumfoɔ NtamkeseƐ against the other Eric Okyere chose to be a successor of the throne after Manso Nkwantamanhene chose and enstooled him and he was dared.

SUGGESTION BY NANANOM

The council suggested that they inquire from the Manso Nkwantamanhene his details and his decision pertaining the case before proceed in this court.

AKYAMFOO'S STATEMENT

He intimated that the council is right just as many Manso Nkwantamanhene also has the right to see into cases about Otumfoɔ Ntam therefore Manso Nkwantamanhene can't be left out on this case. He averred that though the mistake had already happened yet they need to be helped. Therefore, he set a committee to go before Manso Nkwantamanhene.

Didahene averred that since Fawotirikyɛ belongs to Akyamfo according to history, then as they go before Manso Nkwantamanhene, they should label themselves and address Manso Nkwantamanhene as people of Akwamuhene.

KWAME ANANE, ABUSUAPANIN FROM MANSO NKWANTA SPEAKS

He articulated that their Odikro is sick and not strong enough to continue with the kinship so we took the next person to be enstooled as Odikro to swear to Manso Nkwanta and on that very day, another person called Eric Okyere came up said, he is part of the succession of throne. I, Kwame Anane invoked an Oath of Otumfoɔ on Eric Okyere. We were not able to continue with the Enstoolment.

AKYAMFOO SPEAKS

He asked Tetrem, Nkwanta-Esaase and Kyeame Abebrese to go to Manso Nkwanta and inform them about it.

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CLOSURE OF MEETING

He said, yes, they went to Asantehemaa's court and on that very day, they were wearing black and gave them one week to come again because they are not to wear black to Nanahemaa's court on that day.

Kyeame Abebrese said that he did not go to the court with them but he heard from both parties that they have been to Nanahemaa's court.

Kyeame Abebrese pleaded to the council that he will go to Nanahemaa's court to confirm if they have been there.

SUGGESTIONS BY NANANOM

Terchirehene- suggested that the duration Kofi Arhin needs to recover from his illness should be granted to him.

Nkwanta Esaase- Suggested the two months should be given to him.

Didahene- suggested same

Abirahene- retrained same

Kyeame Oti- said same as Nananom has said

AKYAMFOO SPEAKS

He said, he will accept what Nananom have suggested the two months duration shall be granted to Kofi Arhin but should do well to represent himself to the court.

Kofi Arhin has been granted two to appear in October so that the case can be settled. He also said that Abusuapanin Amadu should also settle all the issues at home to bring peace.

Terchirehene- Lets invite the family who went to swear to Yabi and ask them about it.

Ahemoa Gyata- Lets send someone from Akwamu to go and inform Yabi Fekuo Mpanimfoɔ that there is Ntam over here at Akwamu.

Suaduhene- He sided with what Nananom has suggested.

Abusuapanin Frimpong was asked if he has informed Gyaasehene about the case?

He answered that, No, he hasn't informed him.

Therefore, Abusuapanin Frimpong was asked to inform Gyaasehene before they proceed to resolve the case.

Gyaasehene accepted to stand in and continue the case with Abusupanin Frimpong.

JULIET SARFOWAA ANTWI SPEAKS

I bought the land from Mpentuase in the 2021 and I was about to build the land but I realized someone has been on the land in 2023. I asked him and he said the land belongs to him, he bought the land from Bomso Abusuapanin.

I made a complain to the Mpentuase family and later reported the case to Apampatia Police Station to stop them from working on the Land until we find amicable solution.

Q- Do you know the plot number and who signed the allocation Paper

Manwerehene:

Q- Why did you kept long before coming to make Akyamfoɔ allocation paper?

A-

Akrafohene:

Q- Who went to show you the land and what was on the land?

A- Only weeds were on the land.

Akyamfoɔ:

Akyamfour articulated that, Juliet's documents are not valid.

DANIEL SMITH (PASTOR) SPEAKS

I bought the land in 2023 through an agent called Alhaji and he took me to Bonso Abusuapanin. About six months ago, I wanted to go and work on the land. I met someone who was working on the land and he said that he has moulded blocks and I owe him. I told him, I am not responsible for the payment. I requested to see him, so I decided to build one bedroom on the land. I received a call from unknown person that we should halt the works. I did not meet anyone so I decided to go ahead and work on the land.

**ALHAJI ADAM SPEAKS, AGENT WHO LED PASTOR DANIEL SMITH TO BUY
LAND FROM ABUSUAPANIN FRIMPONG AT BOMSO.**

I'm Alhaji Adam from Bawko but I was born at Obuasi. I'm a Real Estate agent. I've worked with Twafo, Maase, Darko Dikro.

When the issue between Bomso and Mpentuse arose in 2022, I was called by Abusuapanin Frimpong to come and work for him. I met Pastor Daniel and he wanted land to buy, I became

the middleman when he brought the money and we went to Gyaasehene and gave the money to him for allocation paper.

NANANOM INTERROGATE ALHAJI ADAMS

Q- I have worked with you before but do I give you allocation paper or you give the money first before I give out the allocation paper.

A- It depends on the chief that I am working with. It's been a year but still there is no allocation paper.

Q- Did you go to the District Assembly to find out before selling the land?

A- No

Dumakwae:

Q- When did you sold the land?

A- 2022

Nkosoohehene:

Q- How long have you been working?

A- 21 years ago

Akyamfo:

Q- How long have you been working?

A- 21 years

Q- Who has the right to sell land?

A- Akyamfo

Akyamfo further stated that, Alhaji has no right to sell any land. The pastor said he bought the land in 2023 and you are also saying 2022.

BOMSO ABUSUAPANIN KWABENA FRIMPONG SPEAKS.

After our land dispute with Mpentuse, we were declared as victors. We needed money for thanks giving and as at that time there were no money so I told Alhaji to get me buyers for the land we had there. The woman made a case against Pastor Daniel and the commander said, he will look into the matter. After sometime, the commander told the Pastor to go and work on the land.

Alhaji said the plot no. 8 is on the right and you are also saying it's on the left, which means both of you don't know where the land is located.

Akyamfo further stated that, Alhaji has no right to sell any land and he will write a letter to lands commission to notify them about it.

Akyamfo set a committee which includes Twafohene, Dumakwae Dikro and Kyeame Osei Broni to go make further investigation.

Case adjourned to next two weeks.

The boundaries for both parties remain unchanged.
